Before the Storm

☐ Reattach loose window shutters and gutters. ☐ Clean and inspect your gutters. ☐ Secure or relocate outdoor belongings such as patio furniture and grills. ☐ Install storm shutters to protect your windows from high winds and debris. ☐ Ensure your home is properly insulated and all windows and doors are sealed. \square Ensure your flashlights have fresh batteries and that you have candles for backup. ☐ Cut and haul away dangerous tree limbs. ☐ Clean and stock to prepare your "safe room" so there's plenty of room and supplies for everyone. ☐ Create an emergency plan and ensure each family member knows it. \square Check your carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. ☐ Stock up on a few days' worth of food and plenty of water in the event of a power outage. \square Board up your windows in the event of a hurricane or tornado. ☐ Landscape strategically to help keep your basement clear of water damage. ☐ Consider purchasing a generator in the event of power outages. ☐ Plug electricity-powered items into surge protectors.

- ☐ Have roof professionally checked for damage.
- ☐ Check for and repair cracks in stucco to prevent water damage.
- ☐ Use a heavy-duty shop vac to remove any standing water underneath carpeting pads.
- \square Shut off your water supply and electricity in the event of water damage.
- ☐ Examine your HVAC unit for any damage.
- ☐ Evaluate home electronics for damage in the event of a power surge.
- \square Spray for mosquitoes in order to enjoy your backyard.
- ☐ Completely and safely remove any mold that may have appeared before applying new paint to your home's exterior.
- ☐ Check your home, decks and fences for any damaged or rotting wood. Replace immediately to maintain the structure's integrity.
